New Business

A. Funding Agreement for Creative City Project Inc.

Creative City Project Inc. is a not-for-profit corporation that strives to cultivate a thriving arts community in Orlando. From February 20-22, 2026, Creative City will host IMMERSE, a three-day arts festival in Downtown Orlando. Supported by month-long art and technology activations and a first in class digital campaign, IMMERSE will showcase the performing arts over 10 blocks in Downtown Orlando. Creative City anticipates that

IMMERSE will bring more than 65,000 guests to the experience, many of whom will also enjoy the offerings of Downtown Orlando's businesses, hotels and restaurants.

Entering into this Funding Agreement will help to achieve the Downtown Development Board's (DDB) goal of making Downtown Orlando a premier arts and culture destination while supporting local businesses. Under the Funding Agreement, the DDB will be contributing \$50,000. Like last year, Orange County has granted Creative City \$1,000,000 for IMMERSE 2026.

Staff requested that the DDB approve the Funding Agreement with Creative City Project Inc., subject to review and approval of the City Attorney's Office, and authorize the Chair and Executive Director to execute the Agreement.

A motion was made by Steve Garrity and seconded by Jason Chin to approve the Agreement with Creative City Project Inc. and authorize the Chair and Executive Director to execute the Agreement, in substantially the formattached subject to the review and approval of the City Attorney's Office. The motion carried unanimously.
